



Operation Zulu is inspired by the events of 1964 in South Africa when the iconic film *Zulu* was being made in Natal while at the same time, Nelson Mandela was being given a life sentence for treason and being transported to Robben Island. We plan to create an epic piece of musical theatre that revolves around the story of a young Welsh boy and a Zulu girl who meet on the film set of Zulu and fall in love but are torn apart by the unforgiving laws of the apartheid system. The story will follow their lives in the succeeding forty odd years until the final unravelling of their story at the London Olympics.

For this ambitious and exciting project we will need a large scale cast covering a whole range of performance skills to work alongside a team of professionals. We will be looking for the following talents and many more to enable us to tell the story in as rich and multi-layered way as possible.

As well as performers and people with all the back stage skills necessary to create a piece of theatre on this scale, we will also be giving opportunities for artists to work alongside and in parallel with the project in disciplines as diverse as:
